About Meningococcal Disease:

- It causes bacterial meningitis and other serious diseases.
- Teens and young adults are at greater risk.
- It comes on quickly and without warning.
- It's symptoms are similar to the flu.
- Every case of this disease can result in death or long-term disability.

Even a child who has had a shot before may need a booster to start school.
