## Bullying, Harassment, or Intimidation Reporting Form

**Directions:** Bullying, harassment, or intimidation are serious and will not be tolerated. If you are a student victim, the parent/guardian of a student victim, a close adult relative of a student victim, or a school staff member and wish to report an incident of alleged bullying, harassment or intimidation, complete this form and return it to Mrs. Tigges. Contact the school for additional information or assistance at any time.

Bullying, harassment, or intimidation means intentional conduct, including verbal, physical, or written conduct or an intentional electronic communication\* that creates a hostile educational environment by substantially interfering with a student's educational benefits, opportunities, or performance, or with a student's physical or psychological well-being and is:

- motivated by an actual or a perceived personal characteristic including <u>race</u>, <u>national origin</u>, <u>marital status</u>, <u>sex</u>, <u>sexual orientation</u>, <u>gender identity</u>, <u>religion</u>, <u>ancestry</u>, <u>physical attributes</u>, <u>socioeconomic status</u>, <u>familial status</u>, or <u>physical or mental ability</u> or <u>disability</u>
- threatening or seriously intimidating; and occurs on school property, at a school activity or event, or on a school bus
- · substantially disrupts the orderly operation of a school

\*\*Electronic communication" means a communication transmitted by means of an electronic device, including a telephone, cellular phone, computer, or pager.
