As we move into summer, I would like to take some time to update and inform you on a couple of things. As a reminder, our final day of school this year is Friday, May 29. Please follow your child's school building's plan for returning borrowed student devices and school materials. Free school meals will continue through June 29th at all of our current meal delivery locations. Next school year we will begin school on August 24th and follow the recently approved district calendar. You can find this district calendar on the school website. At this time, we have no plans to start school earlier than usual.

Recently the state released the Return to Learn plan to all lowa school districts. This plan requires schools to create a distance learning plan for their district that has to be approved by the lowa Department of Education by July 1, 2020. It is our best hope that come August 24th we are able to be back in school and moving forward in our buildings, however we have to prepare for all aspects of what COVID-19 could bring. It is important for families to realize that we will have an approved and required distance learning plan in place and our district will be prepared to put this into play at any time throughout the school year that it may be needed. It is also important to note that this plan is not a voluntary plan, rather a required plan that is graded and attendance is taken.
