We wanted to send out some general information as we gear up for a new school year to provide updates about our school calendar, athletic admission, and to share our new livestream link.

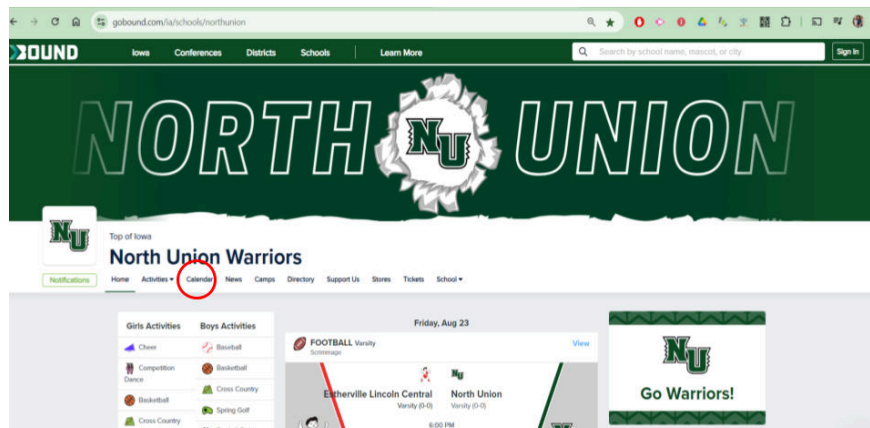
SCHOOL CALENDAR

In the past, our school calendar has used a software called rSchoolToday. We are in the process of transitioning from rSchool to **Bound**, formally known as Varsity Bound. Some of you may be familiar with this app/website as it has been used for varsity athletics for several years. Bound now has a school calendar feature that allows us to put in all of our school events including - early dismissals, field trips, fine arts performances, athletic competitions, etc. To access the school calendar, you can use a web browser or download the Bound app.




- Once on our school page, you can look at each individual program for their respective schedule.
- You can also click on the “CALENDAR” tab to check out our entire school calendar
- (similar to what was done in the past with rSchool)



BOUND APP

- From your app store on your smartphone or other device, search “Bound”.
- Then download the app that looks like this  →
- Once the app is downloaded, you will be prompted to create an account. There is no fee to create an account, it just allows you to follow our school & receive notifications. It will also allow our home page to pop up each time so you only have to search for our school one time.
- Follow the prompts to “follow” North Union High School. From here, you can decide which teams you want notifications from. If you have a child out for football, it would be recommended to turn on the notifications from our football program.
- If you wish to access our entire school calendar from the app, you simply click the ‘Calendar’ icon in the top, left hand corner.  →
- You can also filter the calendar to only show activities your favorite Warriors are in, early dismissal times, concerts, etc.
- *Please be patient as we are transitioning to our new calendar. We do not have everything on the Bound calendar at this time.*

High School Athletic Admission

The Top of Iowa Conference will now be charging \$8/adult and \$5/student to attend varsity competitions. This is a change from \$5/adult & \$5/student that has been the fee over the past several years. There are many reasons for the increase, but primarily, just to help cover the cost to host events (officials pay, livestream cost, etc.). A large majority of TIC schools, and even some surrounding non-conference schools, will no longer be accepting cash at their admission table. You will need to purchase online tickets using the Bound App/Website. This is the same process used for postseason events by the IGHSAU.

For our home events, we will still be accepting cash at the admission gates through the 24-25 school year. We will also accept digital tickets that are purchased ahead of time on bound. Livestream Link

We still plan to livestream all of our home high school events at no cost to our supporters. We also have the capability to livestream home football games this year as well. The new platform that these games will be livestreamed on is through an app/website called Hudl Fan. The URL is: fan.hudl.com/nuwarriors

There is also a 'Hudl Fan' app that can be downloaded on your phone, tablet, smart TV, fire stick, etc. From the app store, search "Hudl Fan" and download the app. It looks like this
